<b>Tools, supplies and reference materials:</b> Career Connection Book 3 Chapter 4 pages: 39-46.	
<b>Methods of instruction:</b> Use the jigsaw method to divide students into small groups. Assign each group a topic from the chapter.	
<b>Task analysis or activities:</b> The group must create a short presentation on the assigned information and present to the class. After the presentation group members will have a chance to discuss how the group used teamwork to accomplish the task.	
<b>Evaluation:</b> Students will be graded on their use of time, safety methods, quality of work, cleaning and organization of their work area, interaction with other students, and employability skills.
